

POINTS SYSTEM

To determine the points values of ships, use the following system.

- Basic Points =
(Broadside x Hull x Ship Factor) + (Crew parties x 10)
- Ship factor
1st - 3rd Rate..... x 1
4th - 6th Rate..... x 0.5
Unrated..... x 0.25
- Modify if the ship is unwieldy:
Unwieldy..... x 0.9
- Modify for Crew Quality, depending on routine being used:
Elite..... x 1.4
Veteran or Grade I x 1.2
Experienced or Grade II..... x 1.0
Poor or Grade III..... x 0.8
- Modify for Ship Type within rate:
Inferior x 0.9
Superior..... x 1.1

- As final stage round to nearest whole number.
Example: An inferior 2nd Rate, with Broadside and Hull Rating 11, 5 crew parties, Veteran crew.
Basic Points: (11 x 11 x 1) + (5 x 10) = 171.000
Crew Quality: 171x1.2 = 205.200
Inferior in rate: 205.2 x 0.9 = 184.680
Round to nearest whole number = 185.000
- Admirals are rated for Command Quality, depending on routine being used:
Superior..... 140
Inspired or Grade I 120
Average or Grade II 100
Inept or Grade III..... 80
